Some good news. It is hoped that meetings at the woodshed will resume by mid-November and following a recent Committee meeting plans are currently being put in place for this.

To meet rising operating costs some radical changes in the way we operate were also discussed. A partnership has been formed with Sam and Lynda to promote Woodturning in Northern Ireland. Our activities will no longer require membership of the IWG but members will be asked to contribute an annual membership fee of £30 to Ulster Woodturning.

Tuesday evenings will be run by Ulster Woodturning (entry £6) A discount of £2 will be given to Ulster Woodturning members. Demo will be provided by local turners.

Monthly Meetings will once again take place every 2^{nd} Saturday afternoon 2 – 5pm and the Wood Shed will remain open exclusively for Ulster Woodturning Members . The cost of attending monthly meetings will be £10 with a charge for all day demos being set according to costs attributed to that day.

It has been some time since costs to members have been increased and our financial position has become increasingly difficult is hoped that these changes will place us on a firmer financial footing.

Unfortunately, the first few meetings will not have refreshments available. It is hoped that a new covid safe refreshments area will become available by January.

In response to Covid19 safety, those attending will be asked to use hand sanitizer, wear a mask at all times and be responsible in terms of social distancing. Any one who is feeling unwell or named as a close contact is asked not to attend for the recommended period.






Many thanks to all those who contributed and those members who are currently producing Christmas trees.
